How to ensure water sustainably and democratically for industry, PtX, and cities?

Although Denmark has a strong tradition for developing and giving advice on water technology, the sector suffers from a lack of investment in new infrastructure, research, and innovation.

At the same time, challenges such as water supply and water quality have suddenly become more immediate to citizens, who are now hearing about groundwater contamination, floods, and oxygen depletion in coastal sea areas.

At the meeting on August 20, we will discuss how we can ensure a sustainable water supply when growing cities and industries associated with the green transition and healthcare (e.g. Power2X, pharmaceuticals, etc.) increase the pressure on water resources, and what role local communities and local decision makers can play to ensure supply, development, and better framework conditions.
